

Cooperation Agreement between Trinity College London and ACEIA (The Association of Private Language Schools in Andalucía)

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between

María González, President of ACEIA (The Association of Private Language Schools in Andalucía)

And

Erez Tocker, Chief Executive, authorized by, and for and on behalf of Trinity College London, to enter into this Agreement.

The parties have mutually acknowledged sufficient legal capacity, and further acknowledge that their powers have not expired nor been revoked, to enter into this Cooperation Agreement and to this end:

BACKGROUND

FIRST. The purpose of the parties is to develop actions in the educational field and, more specifically, in EFL teaching, learning and assessment.

SECOND. As established by the Common European Framework for Languages, language and culture learning and development in Europe constitute a key element in the education of European youth that will foster social and professional integration.

THIRD. Trinity is a leading international awarding organisation, education publisher and independent education charity with over 150 years of expertise. They pursue our purpose primarily through the provision of exams, assessments, consultancy, training and the publication of relevant materials. Their qualifications, which span music, performance, English language and communication skills, are designed to be rewarding to teach and enjoyable to prepare for. Their staff set academic standards, develop specifications, syllabuses and exams, devise marking schemes, process exam entries, and administer the worldwide exams programme, resulting in the award of qualification certificates and diplomas. They are regulated by the Office of Qualifications and Examinations Regulation (Ofqual) in England, the Council for Curriculum, Examinations and Assessment in Northern Ireland, and Qualifications Wales.

Both ISE and GESE tests taken in Secure English Language Test (SELT) Centres in the UK are approved and accepted by the UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) for settlement and multiple visa application purposes.

Trinity College London is a member of the Association of Language Testers in Europa (ALTE). In 2012 GESE and ISE were awarded the ALTE 'Q' Quality mark – evidence of meeting all 17 of ALTE's stringent quality standards.

Digital-first investment to meet customer demand. Across their portfolio, Trinity is increasingly operating a digital-first approach in product development and operations, in line with customer expectations and demand. They expanded the use of digital certificates, syllabuses and publications, enabling faster turnaround times, delivering environmental benefits and providing a broader range of customer choices.

Celebrating a decade of Trinity SELT. In 2025, they proudly celebrated 10 years of Trinity's Secure English Language Test (SELT), a major milestone in their work supporting individuals seeking to live, work and study in the UK. Since they launched, more than one million learners have taken a Trinity SELT. With over 146,000 exams delivered in 2025 and a 97% satisfaction rate, Trinity SELT has become a cornerstone of trusted, secure English language testing. They mark this milestone not only in numbers, but in the transformative journeys they have supported, driven by innovation, inclusion and impact.

FOURTH. The Association of Private Language Schools in Andalucía (ACEIA) brings together language teaching centres across Andalucía and is the professional association representing the sector. Thousands of students attend ACEIA-associated centres every year.

FIFTH. ACEIA and Trinity College London, hereafter TCL, wish to establish and develop a relationship to improve quality in the teaching and learning of foreign languages, in order to evaluate the learning process of ACEIA schools' students.

For all the above, the parties hereto agree as follows:

CLAUSES

FIRST. Purpose.

The purpose of this Agreement is to establish a framework for cooperation between ACEIA and TCL to promote English language teaching, learning and assessment in ACEIA schools.

SECOND. Obligations of the Parties.

1. ACEIA hereby commits to the following:

- Promote registration of Trinity College London examination centres among its affiliated schools under Trinity's rules and agreements pertaining thereto.

- Promote joint cultural events and information campaigns with Trinity College London.

- Facilitate the means to fulfil the purpose of this Agreement

2. Trinity College London hereby commits to the following:

- Register ACEIA schools wishing to become TCL Registered Examination Centres under the established rules as contained in the contracts pertaining thereto, and facilitate the organization of examination sessions as far as possible.

- Register ACEIA schools wishing to become ISE Digital TCL Registered Examination Centres under the established rules as contained in the contracts pertaining thereto, and facilitate the organization of examination sessions as far as possible.
 - Maintain as TCL registered examination centres those ACEIA schools that were registered examination centres prior to the signing of this Agreement under the established rules as contained in the contracts pertaining thereto.
 - Provide free training to ACEIA teachers on dates and locations to be mutually agreed by the parties.
 - Subject to agreement between the parties, to offer special terms and conditions to ACEIA centres, as previously agreed between the parties.
 - To be listed in Trinity College London's national centre directory, with specific reference to their membership in FECEI. The national directory of Trinity centres continually receives requests for Trinity examination and exam preparation centres.

- Promote joint cultural events and media information campaigns with ACEIA.
- Facilitate the means to fulfil the purpose of this Agreement.

THIRD. Monitoring and Control Commission.

In order to resolve any issues that may arise from the interpretation and fulfilment of this Agreement, a Monitoring and Control Commission shall be constituted which shall interpret the doubts which might arise regarding the content of this Agreement and shall coordinate, develop and carry out the activities foreseen.

The said Commission shall resolve any issues and conflicts arising from the interpretation and performance of this Agreement.

The Commission shall be formed by the following members:

- a- For ACEIA – Ms María González
- b- For Trinity College London – Mr Manuel Vidal

The Commission shall meet at least once a year and as often as is deemed convenient.

FOURTH. Intellectual Property

The Charity Trinity College London hereby grants ACEIA the personal, non-transferable, non-assignable right (with no right to sub-license), free of property rights on a non-exclusive basis, to use the name and logo of Trinity College London to refer to and promote its collaboration with Trinity College London under this Agreement and provided always ACEIA complies with any restriction and/or limitation in the use of said name and/or logo as may be notified to ACEIA from time to time.

FIFTH. Term.

This Agreement shall be in force from 28th February 2026 until 28th February 2030, and shall be automatically extended for successive two-year periods, unless otherwise expressly notified by either or both parties.

SIXTH. Termination and notifications.

This Agreement may be terminated for any of the following reasons:

- a. By mutual agreement by the parties.
- b. For breach of any of the terms and/or covenants.
- c. If replaced by a new Agreement.
- d. Any other cause contemplated in current legislation.

In case of termination, the Monitoring and Control Commission shall take the necessary steps to ensure the fulfilment of any pending obligations under rules and regulations in force at the time of termination.

SEVENTH. Governing Law and Entire Agreement.

This Agreement is of an administrative nature and therefore any conflicts arising from its interpretation, modification, termination and effects shall be submitted to the jurisdiction of the administrative courts.

This Agreement (together with any documents expressly incorporated by reference and any other terms expressly stated to apply) constitutes the entire agreement of the parties with respect to its subject matter and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings, negotiations, communications, and representations relating to such subject matter.

In witness whereof the parties have signed this Agreement, consisting of two identical copies that shall jointly constitute one single instrument.
